TRAVELLING TO PLAY LASER TAG

It's cheapest to book and stay in apartment style accommodation while away at the Laser Tag Tournaments. This could be in a chain like Quest or Best Western or even at a BIG4 Caravan park that has chalets. Or even find a holiday house for rent in the area near the hosting site. A place where your own team/squad can stay all together is always fun and even more fun if you can stay somewhere nearby other teams too.

Keep in mind that the place you are travelling to may have very different weather to where you are travelling from so check out the local weather at your destination before packing.

A week of Laser Tag can be quite exhausting drink plenty of water and keep up your vitamins either through eating healthily or taking vitamin supplements.

Also think about designing a team shirt so your team/squad all look the part. It is quite traditional at Laser Tag events to swap shirts with the opposing players at the end of the tournament so think about buying yourself more than one of your team shirts so you can keep one and trade one or two.

Budget in some spending money for time spent socialising or checking out some tourist locations while you are away. We do try to give you spare time to explore while you're visiting.

We have our own café which will be open each day for purchasing food, coffee, tea, hot chocolate, milkshakes and slushies. Most of our normal food is deep fried but for the Titles we are looking at having other dishes available each for purchase.

If you're after more variety it's only a very short drive to Nando's, Subway, Chinese, Red Rooster, MacDonalds, Hungry Jacks and more with a few lunchbars in walking distance.

We run a Super Session on Friday and Saturday Nights and on Saturday 20th August we have booked out the entire session to Titles players only and included it in your nomination fee. We have also started it 1.5 hours early so it'll be a 4.5 hour session with some fun games and practice games so you can learn the maze before the Tournament starts.

There is ample parking for your hire cars so you won't be paying for parking. Plenty of foyer space and room outside for getting some privacy to have your team talks.

We have arcade games and redemption machines to keep you entertained between games. I'm sure people will also bring along card games etc to help waste the time between games when not strategizing.

We are only a 20-25min drive from Perth City and similar distance from Joondalup. Morley has a huge shopping centre only about 10mins drive away from the site.
